1. Development contracts

TEMPORARY FRAMEWORK 2.8

- Only grants
- Specific for strategic investments aimed at the netzero goal
- Applications in a limited period of time
- Aid intensity: from 15% to 55% according to company size and location
- No notification to EU for investments > 110 M€

GENERAL BLOCK EXEMPTION REGULATION

- Grants and soft loans, with possibility to mix
- All manufacturing activities
- Always possible to file applications
- Aid intensity: grants from 10% to 60% according to company size and location, reducing with growing loans
- Notification to EU for investments > 110 M€

NZIA implementation-Slovenia

- ✓ NZIA transposition in progress ☺
- ✓ Non-financial criteria for support schemes and public funding as an option
- ✓ Enabling OPEX subsidies (not spec. for producers)
- Technology- neutral appoach (support to nuclear energy)
- **❖**SOLAR CHARTER update
 - No specific direct funds- endavours in raising awareness on existing (EU) and national funding options
 - Application for CAPEX funding by solar panel producer (no results yet) not based on the Charter



Funding Solar and Storage

Slovenia is leveraging **three interconnected funding mechanisms** to accelerate its solar energy and storage rollout:

- EU Recovery and Resilience Plan (RRP)
- REPowerEU Chapter (RRP extension)
- Temporary Crisis and Transition Framework (TCTF) State aid scheme

What is good:

- Digitilized
- Many oppurtunities for solar+storage funding (higher subsidies with storage)

What we're missing:

- specific storage funding (limited for residential with existing PV)
- Transperancy in planned funding + system of aquiring the funds
- Complexitiy in some cases
